If you do not already have a meter with these capabilities, a new one will need to be installed. Your utility will source and install your new meter, and this won't affect your project cost in most cases.

After your solar panels are physically installed, a mandatory local building inspection takes place to confirm the system meets all safety and electrical codes. Once the system passes this inspection, the utility is notified, ...

Aside from the major small renewable energy system components, you will need to purchase some additional equipment (called "balance-of-system") in order to safely transmit electricity to your loads and

If bi-directional meters aren't available, you'll have to install two separate meters: one for electricity supplied by the grid and one for electricity sent back by the solar panel system.
